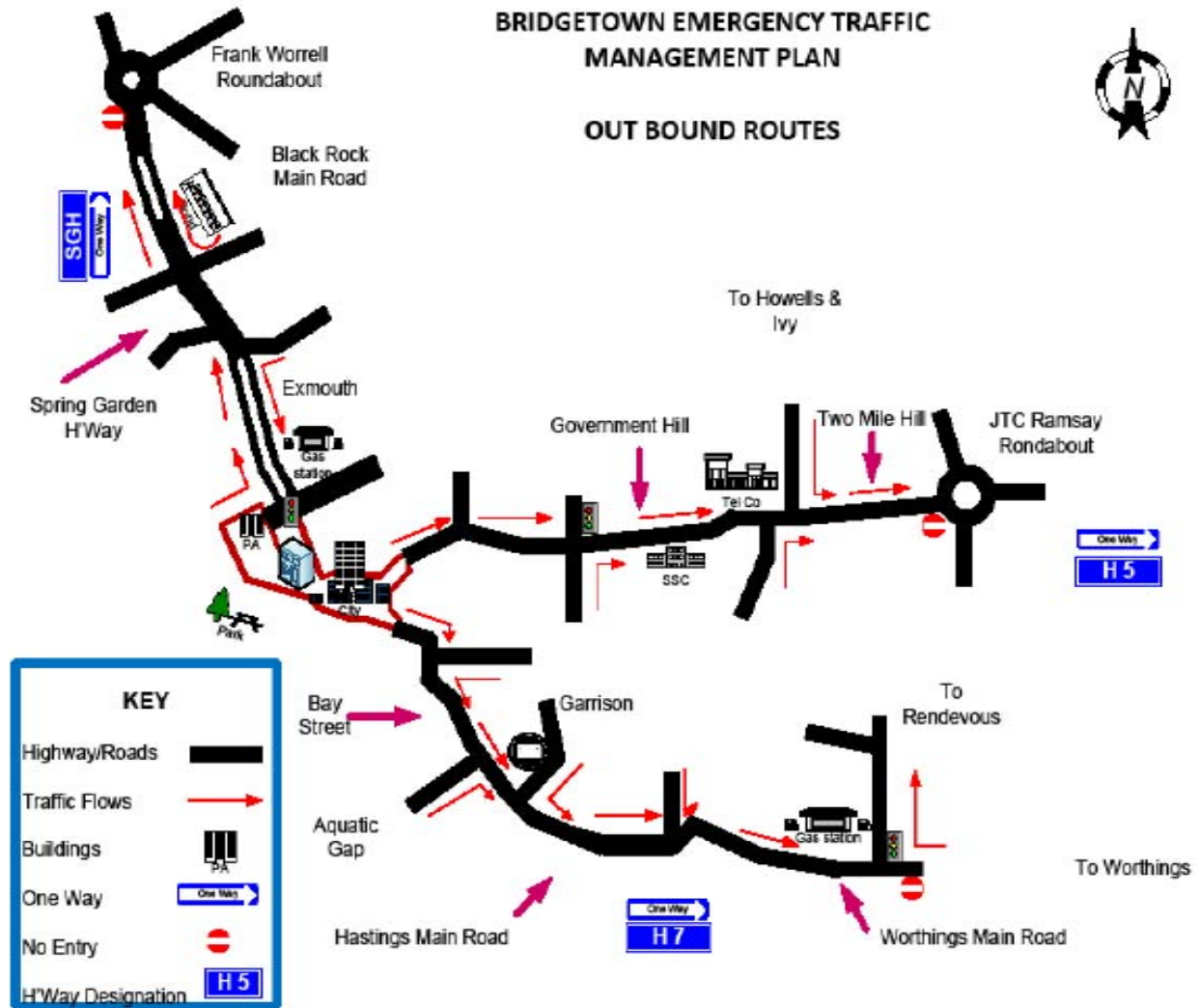


BRIDGETOWN EMERGENCY TRAFFIC MANGEMENT PLAN



In event of an emergent situation for which an order has been given to close the city of Bridgetown the following actions will take place:

- Notification will be given to members of the public via the media.
- Police Officers will be deployed to the city, major highways, roundabouts and junctions to assist with the direction of traffic.
- Road Signs and or Bulletins will be strategically place along the routes.
- Contra-flows will be established on the Spring Garden Highway, Highways 7 and 5 to facilitate the movement of traffic out of the city.

OUT BOUND ROUTES

Routes taking traffic away from the city will be establish as follows:

- **Spring Garden Highway**
 - Exit City via Princess Alice Highway turning right to Prescod Boulevard, then in two (2) lanes to Elsie Payne Roundabout; along President Kennedy Drive turning left on to Spring Garden to the Frank Worrell Roundabout.
- **Highway 7**
 - Exit City via Bay Street in two (2) lanes along Hastings, Rockley to Highway 7 Rendezvous junction.
- **Highway 5**
 - Exit City via Roebuck Street in one lane (normal flow) to Tweedside Road junction with Welches; then in two (2) lanes along Government Hill, Two Mile Hill to the JTC Ramsay (Bussa) Roundabout.
- **White Park Road**
 - Exit City via White Park Road in one lane (normal flow) to Bank Hall, Bush Hall Road, Waterford to Clyde Walcott Roundabout.

TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS

The following traffic restrictions will be enforced:

- Spring Garden Highway will be closed to inbound vehicular traffic from Frank Worrell Roundabout to Exmouth Junction.
- Highway 5 will be one-way from Government Hill, Tweedside Road Junction to the JTC Ramsay (Bussa) Roundabout.
- All traffic joining the Outbound Routes will turn left or right joining the traffic flows.
- Vehicles joining the Spring Garden Highway between Exmouth and Holbourn will turn left at Holbourn on to President Kennedy Drive or go straight on to Fontabelle.
- Vehicles traveling along Spring Garden to Frank Worrell Roundabout will proceed either side of the center refuge before reaching Four Seasons Hotel.
- Public Service Vehicles (P.S.V's) from Highway 5 (Mapp Hill) will turn right at J.T.C. Ramsay (Bussa) Roundabout on to Barrow section of the A.B.C. Highway, then left at Norman Niles travelling along Highway 4, to

Welches Road, Fountain Road and Belmont Road. Public Service Vehicles out of the City will travel along Government Hill.

- Public Service vehicles (PSV'S) travelling Highway 7 will turn right at Rendezvous Road, left onto Rockley Road, right at Dayrells Road proceeding to the Garrison; then right on Dalkeith Road, left at Dalkeith Hill traffic lights, right at Culloden Road traffic lights, then left to Lower Collymore Rock to Ena Walters Roundabout, River Road, Fairchild Street.

- Oistins to Speightstown By-Pass will continue on regular route on reaching the Garrison.

IN BOUND ROUTES

Traffic seeking to enter the city should utilize routes other than the out bound routes and should join the traffic flows on leaving the city.

These routes are:

- Highway 1
- Highway 2
- Highway 3
- Highway 4
- Highway 6

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
